Benjamin Salvador de la Peña, state of Quintana Roo, México.

We are registered at the federal tax administration with the Federal Contributors Number THU030120DG3 (See attachment)

At the present time we are applying to be an authorized NGO for receive donations deductibles of taxes. Our funding is with our own resources and small donations of the people who know us and believe in what we are doing.

Our social objects are:

1.- To promote the rural development through the professionalism of their organizations and their people. To achieve this, the association will offer to the rural communities training with specialized and technical knowledge for the success of their crops, giving also permanent support for the traffic and market positioning of their agricultural products in sectors for their best convenience.

The way that this knowledge and training will be offer will be with the creation of communitarian centers with classrooms where the agricultures and members of indigenous communities could access at any time to receive the appropriate support to improve their own subsistence conditions as a benefit for him or her, for their families and the communities from where they belong.

2.- To promote the human quality in the commercial relations and the production process of all sectors of the country. To achieve this the association will contact the different sectors related with the agriculture to ask them that in a solidarity way they integrate this producers in their suppliers lists, and this way let them integrate also to the productive activities of the country, making stronger the micro-productive chains that we will be activating and supporting permanently in the different rural communities all along the country. All this for their own wellbeing.

3.- To promote the develop of studies and investigation focused to increase the quality level of life of the human being. To achieve this, the association will maintain permanently programs and commissions of study and investigation to make the knowledge that we will offer to the people be professional and vanguardist, in this direction the people of the communities they could improve their quality of life as a human beings.

Our interest to assist to the Cancun 5th Ministerial is to learn more in how the international trade works, so this way make our job more professional. We are studying the first draft of modalities for the further commitments of the negotiations on agriculture because it is something very close from what happening here in Cancun. Cancun is the jungest city of Mexico, just 32 years old, his economy is in 85% touristic activities oriented. Since September 11 the hotel industry fall down and considerable number of workers with their families who depend from this industry have no jobs anymore, so they want to return to the agriculture but this sector needs a deep regulation and establish a fair and market-oriented trading system through a programme of fundamental reform encompassing strengthened rules and specific commitments on support and protection in order to correct and prevent restrictions and distortions in world agricultural markets.

This is why we are very interested to be part and learn how can we participate to develop such improves in this field. We don't have publications yet, because we was focused with the people at the battle field, in the communities where they need tools to restart their sows, but after this ministerial event I'm sure we will.
